ON30 Gauge

Four Feather Falls

The layout is to ON30 scale (7mm/ft O gauge running on HO track) and is in fact two layouts. The upper part being a logging line, The lower line servicing the mine at the right hand side. A Large fiddle yard behind the back scene allows a variety of stock to be seen.



Located in a mountainous area, a feature of the layout is a gorge where the Feather River gushes under three bridges. The upper is of A Frame construction, the middle is a Truss Frame and the lower is a massive Trestle. All bridges in this neck of the woods, would have been of timber construction as plentiful supplies of the raw materials were available. All bridges were Scratch Built by one of the layout constructors, and by unanimous vote of the Club members were named the "Melville Bridges."

The layout requires a space of 18ft x 8ft including barriers and operating space.
